Be aware, that it can get difficult sometimes, as some of our visitors are very demanding, greedy, cheeky and prone to get irritated very easily reacting harshly towards us.

We need your prayers brothers, for protection, wisdom and guidance to deal with the people we serve here.

We acknowledge here that everything comes from our loving Father in heaven, He is the One who enables us to love and to serve with patience in spite of all the hindrances.

"Love does no harm to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfillment of the law." (Rom 13:10)

What follows is a nice and encouraging little story.

It is already a miracle when a New Testament enters a Jewish house and even more, when a young girl begins to read it!

This happens, whenever there is a believer living in that house who is sharing the message of salvation with his wife and with the daughters.

We talk about Hilik, a dear brother who came to faith and got baptized not long time ago. He is in his "first love" and thus, very passionate about Yeshua, for he has found in the Gospel, the answers that he had not been able to find in his troubled past life.

His family, seeing the changes that God is working in Hilik's life, is encouraged to believe and to know more!

By the way, we, as the body of Messiah are also committed in the distribution of biblical literature and tracts to the people of Israel. Whether we hand them out in the street during the outreach, whether we bring them into their houses during a visit, we make sure that everyone gets the word of God, one way or another.

Please pray for this family and specifically for Oshrat, the girl whom you see reading a small copy of the N.T. in the picture, and her mother Florin, for, as we know, there is power in the word of God.

"The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me, Because the LORD has anointed Me To preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives, And the opening of the prison to those who are bound:..." (Isaiah 61:1)

As you have read on the first lines of this letter, these verses speak firstly about Jesus' ministry and secondly about his disciples. He sent them everywhere to proclaim the gospel confirming the preaching of the word with signs and wonders. We are here among the "brokenhearted"; The King James version bible, renders the expression "to heal" with "bind up". You will see from the pictures that we namely "bind up" the actual wounds our people have, some of them are severe and are a physical reflection of the wounds of the soul, which only Yeshua can bind and heal.

Dear beloved of God, times are getting dark and challenging all the more; nevertheless we are the light of the world, not to be put under a basket but to shine in every place God has put us.

Yeshua is our saviour, our redeemer, our Lord, our peace, our hope, our comfort, our helper in times of need, He is faithful! There are no sufficient words to describe who He is and what He does.

He has chosen to dwell in you and in me, in us.

Keep honouring Him in your bodies, in everything you do every day, do not get distracted by the things of this world and keep resisting the devil through humility, faith and obedience, for we have been given everything to fight the good fight until the end.
