Shalom dear brothers and sisters in Yeshua!

We yearn to God's wonderful promises to Israel spoken through His prophets and praise Him, for having brought us so far by His mercies!

He is always at work, therefore, we will always have something to say that brings glory to His name.

Let us read a commandment that serves us to introduce a testimony to you all:

"nor shall a man put on a woman's garment, for all who do so are an abomination to the LORD your God."(Deut 22:5)

The apostle Paul says: "...the Law is Holy, and the commandment holy and just and good." (Rom 7:12); however, the Law, makes us aware of our sin and brings the judgment of God upon us.

We often have the chance to talk to some of the trans-genders that visit our soup-kitchen, whom have lately showed more openness to listen to the Gospel of Yeshua.

One of them, so called Tal, shared recently with us the testimony of his life. We were glad to listen and to share in his suffering and burdens.

As a result we could tell him about the love of God and His remedy, which are in Yeshua Ha Mashiach (Jesus Christ). It also gave us the chance to pray for specific needs.

Tal can behave rather outrageously, sliding sometimes into severe temper tantrums, shouting and even hitting people in the street. Occasionally, he has been quite hostile towards some of us also.

However, since we have had some conversation and showed him acceptance and love he has become more gentle, nice and grateful towards us.

Let us praise only our Father, for we love this people because He loved us first! and please pray for the salvation of Tal.

As you know, we serve in a very deprived area where there is an awful physical and spiritual reality: women and men (transgender) prostitute themselves alike, they take drugs in front of our very eyes; some of them are very shabby and filthy and some become skinnier day after day.

Moreover, some of the women behave sometimes very unseemly, changing their clothes and getting naked in front of us.

At any time, women and men alike, lay on the sidewalk to sleep or because they are stoned, and mice come along turning around them!

As you can imagine, these people need desperately a miracle from God to get out of such a life!

In spite of our imperfection, Yeshua sent us to preach the good news to the poor, to heal the sick, to cast out demons and we are willing and committed to do so earnestly with His help.

Please, we urge you to pray for us to this regard, in order for us to exercise the authority that God has given us and for the Lord to follow the preaching with signs and wonders!

Pray for deliverance, forgiveness and the fullness of the Holy Spirit.

What follows is an encouraging testimony for you to rejoice.

Sasha is a Russian man who spent most of his life in the street as a homeless.

At some point of his life, he repented and started to follow Yeshua. We have seen that his life is producing the fruits of repentance and he lives in a decent manner now.

He comes to our place, every now and then, to share the good news to his fellow countrymen in this area.

God has not changed dear brethren, He does not sleep nor slumber!

Halleluyah! He is mighty to save! As He did it with Sasha and with us, He will also do it with many of those we are reaching here.

*“Restore to me the joy of Your salvation,
And uphold me by Your generous Spirit.
Then I will teach transgressors Your ways,
And sinners shall be converted to You.”(Psalm 51:12-13)*

Brothers and sisters, let us be our desire and prayer, to become more like our Lord Yeshua, for this is God’s purpose for us.

Likewise, we desire to be involved “in his business” when He will come: preaching, serving, trading with our talents, just as Yeshua says in one of his parables:

“He also who had received two talents came and said, ‘Lord, you delivered to me two talents; look, I have gained two more talents besides them.’ His lord said to him, ‘Well done, good and faithful servant; you have been faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.’”

(Mt 25: 23)
