Shalom and blessings from the Land of Israel brothers and sisters.

What a blessed assurance! The Lord's kindness will never depart from us, for our Father is loving and faithful. No matter the circumstances, He will always meditate good thoughts for us out of His kindness. Several things have happened over the last two months; here you have a few testimonies of how our Great God keeps working.

"Because He delights in mercy, He will again have compassion on us, and will subdue our iniquities." (Micah 7:19)

The following amazing account was reported by one of our sisters who works with us at the soup-kitchen, particularly reaching out the prostitutes in the street:

"Nearly one month ago, on Thursday, other believers and myself, went out from the soup-kitchen to distribute food and clothes in the street. It started to rain heavily as we stood in front of a brothel.

One of the harlots who was at the entrance, named Tanya, called us to enter into her room to take shelter. There was another harlot named Lisa in the brothel.

We sat there for at least one hour talking about life; the two women started to open their hearts and told us about their hatred for men.

A week later, I went out with another group: Moshe, Adriana, Hannah and me. Moshe told me to come in to talk to Tanya again, for she would have listened to me and would have been saved.

Thus, we went to the cubicle where she was in with Lisa. I talked and prayed with both of them about Yeshua. Later, also Adriana talked to Lisa.

On the other hand, another woman, called Katia, suddenly opened her heart and whispered to me secrets and plans she had for the future, including a desire to start a new life.

Our sister Hannah, began to worship the Lord through singing, when the presence and power of the Holy Spirit in that small place, brought everybody down to our knees to pray (including the three harlots!). That evening Tania and Lisa received Yeshuah (Jesus) into their hearts. Hallelujah!

Katia, instead, began to say, from the bottom of her heart: "ABBA, ABBA" (father, father, in Hebrew), then I immediately remembered a verse from the Epistle to the Romans 8:15

"For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, Abba, Father."

Over the last period of time, our sister Shulamite, met with Katia several times. Katia turned out to be a Russian Jewish lady who made "aliyah" some time ago and also was the madam of the brothel, but listen to this brethren, to our joy and to the glory of God; we learnt that Katia repented and accepted Yeshua as her saviour. Later on, she closed the brothel and is planning to leave the country! Hallelujah!

Now we will tell you about two young men. Morat, is a chap who visited us recently, looking for clothes and food. We gladly provided him with both and afterwards he was very happy and grateful for the way we treated him. As usual, we told him about the salvation in Yeshua and gave him a copy of the New Testament.

You may remember about Alexander, a young French Jewish man who visited us regularly in the past. After a while without seeing him, he got back and sat along with us. We are committed to make our guests feel like at home, we are like a family hosting their children and showing them affection, whichever way we can. During that visit, we watered the seed of the Gospel that had been already planted in Alexander's life. As a result, Alexander agreed to download a Bible application into his phone to read God's plan for all men and particularly for him.

Please pray for the women that their acquaintance with Yeshua will deepen, and that HE will open a door for them to a new life, far from the circle of prostitution and the dark area where they currently live. Please keep also in prayer those you have just read about and for the young men whose lives have slept into the bondage of drug addiction and sexual perversion.

In spite of this world crisis, we keep working to advance the Kingdom of God over here. Furthermore, we can do that more freely as the restrictions are ending: the green pass has been banned and tourists are being allowed into Israel back again.

On the current conflict between Russia and Ukraine we can say that we are very displeased for it and for the humanitarian catastrophe that is bringing.

We pray that both sides involved in this conflict may realize the true peace, which lies only in the Prince of Peace, Yeshua HaMashiach and may many people, out of this great turmoil turn to God and experience his wonderful Salvation.

Some of you are asking about this topic, so that, we will send you soon separate notes on this current conflict and its connection with the end times.

Brothers and sisters in Yeshua, we do not want to fear wars neither those who can kill the body. We only want to allow the fear of the Lord into our lives through obedience, submission, holiness and reverence unto Him; for He is King forever and ever. Amén, amén!
